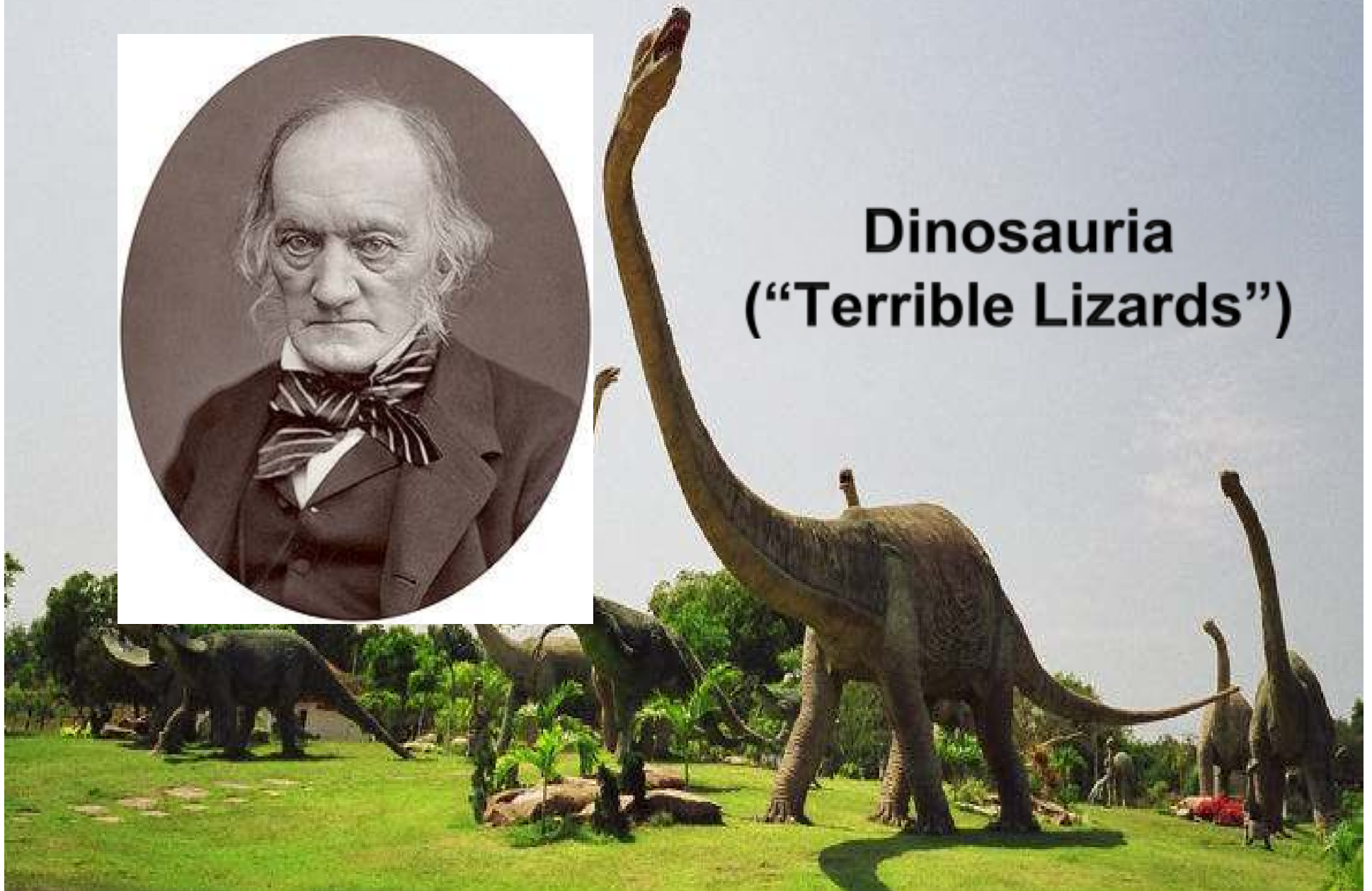




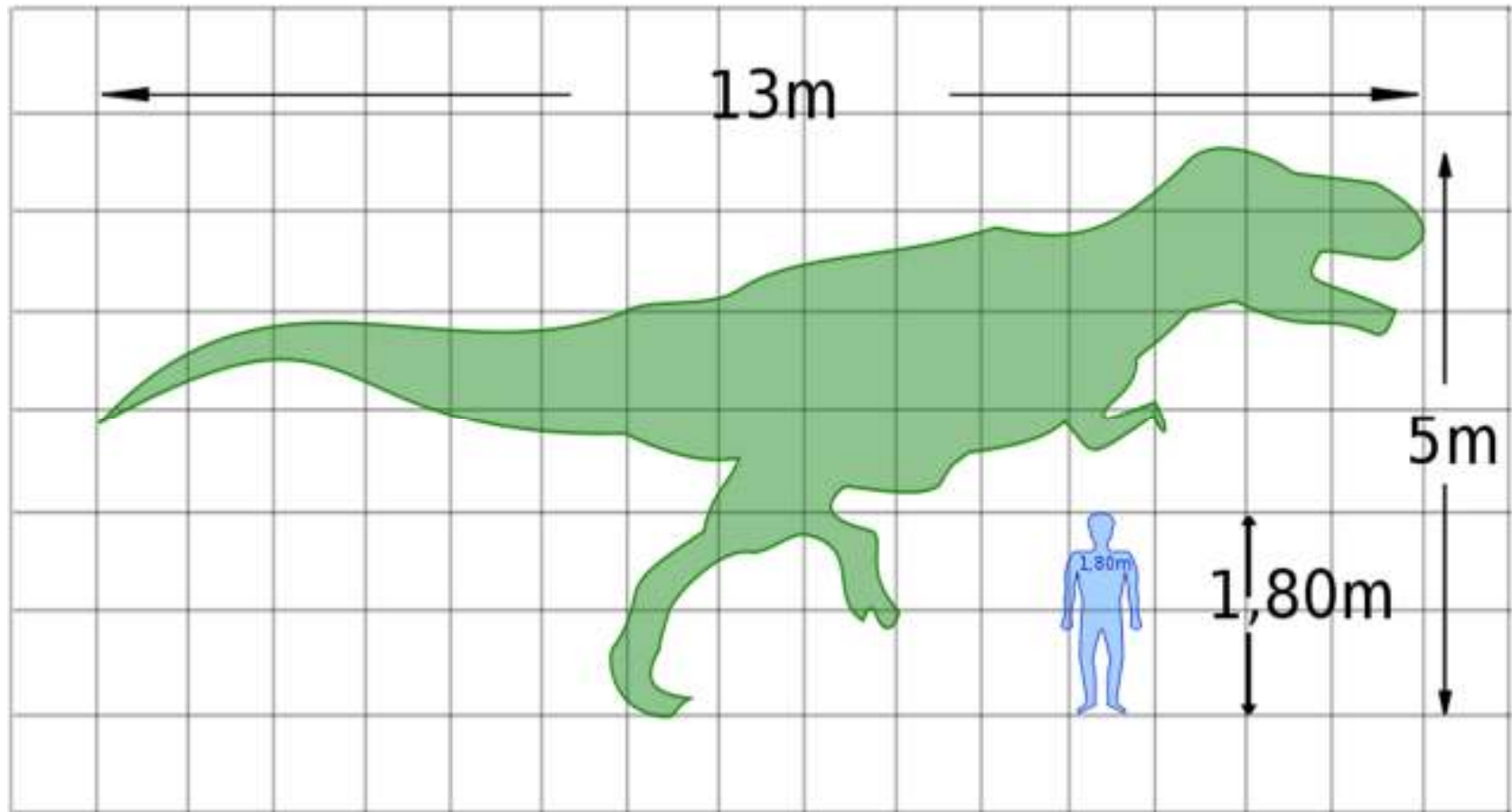




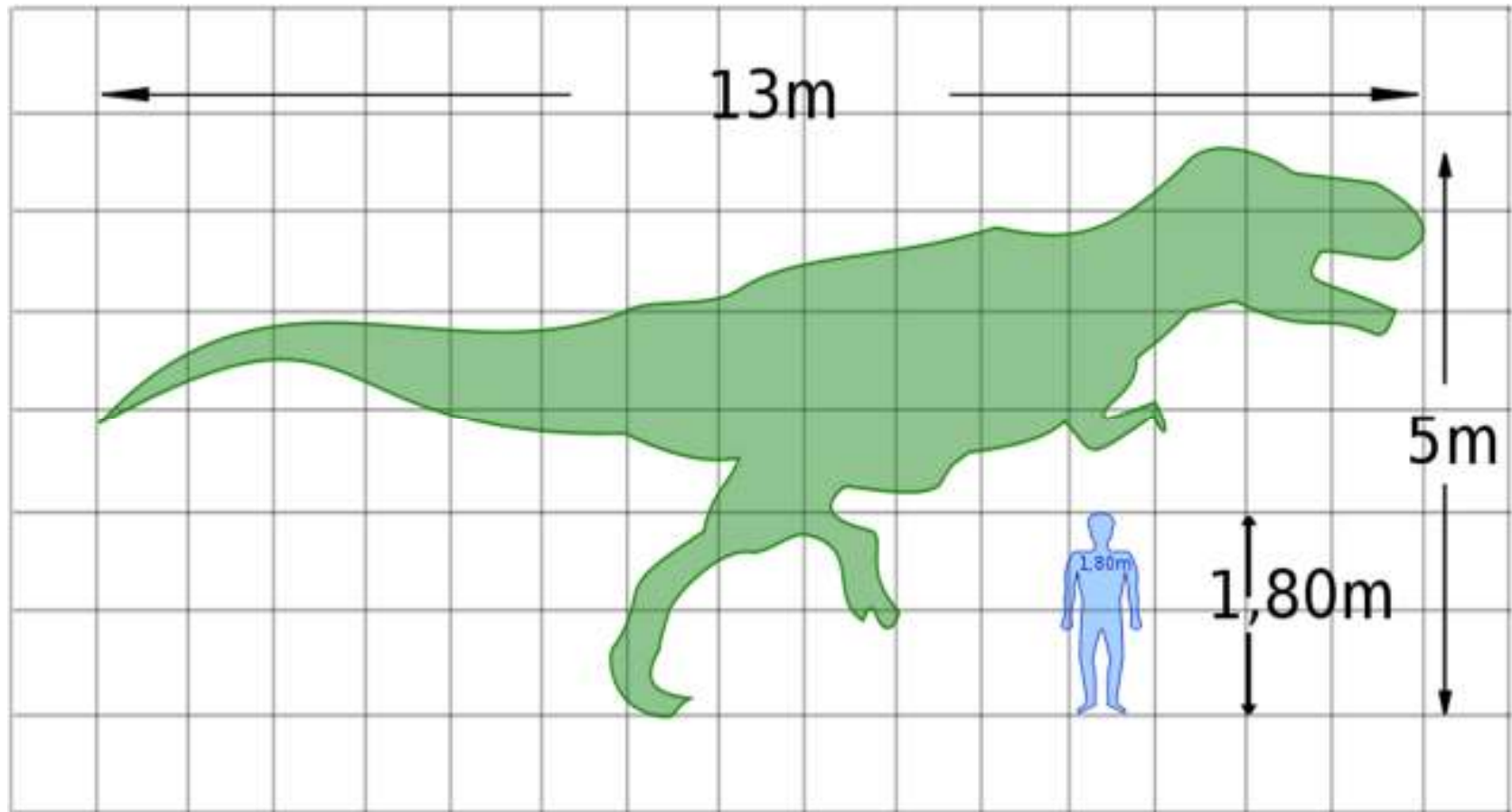
Dinosauria ("Terrible Lizards")

Dragons also mentioned in Ezekiel 29:2-3; 32:1-2 and Isaiah 27:1



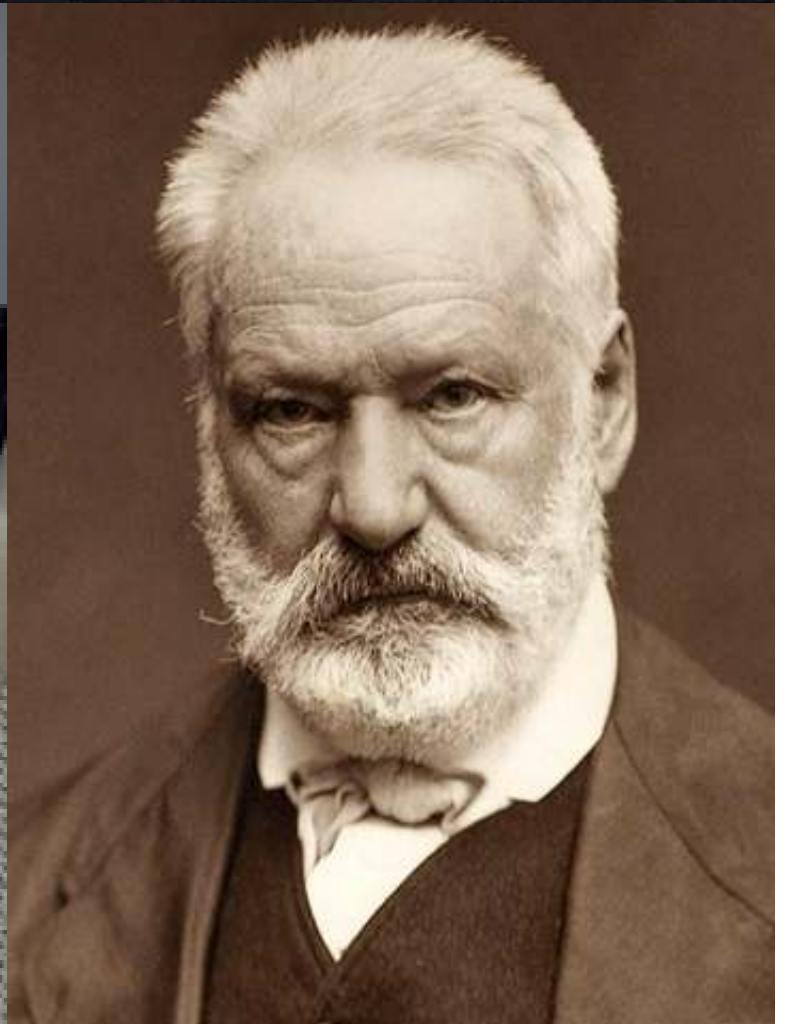

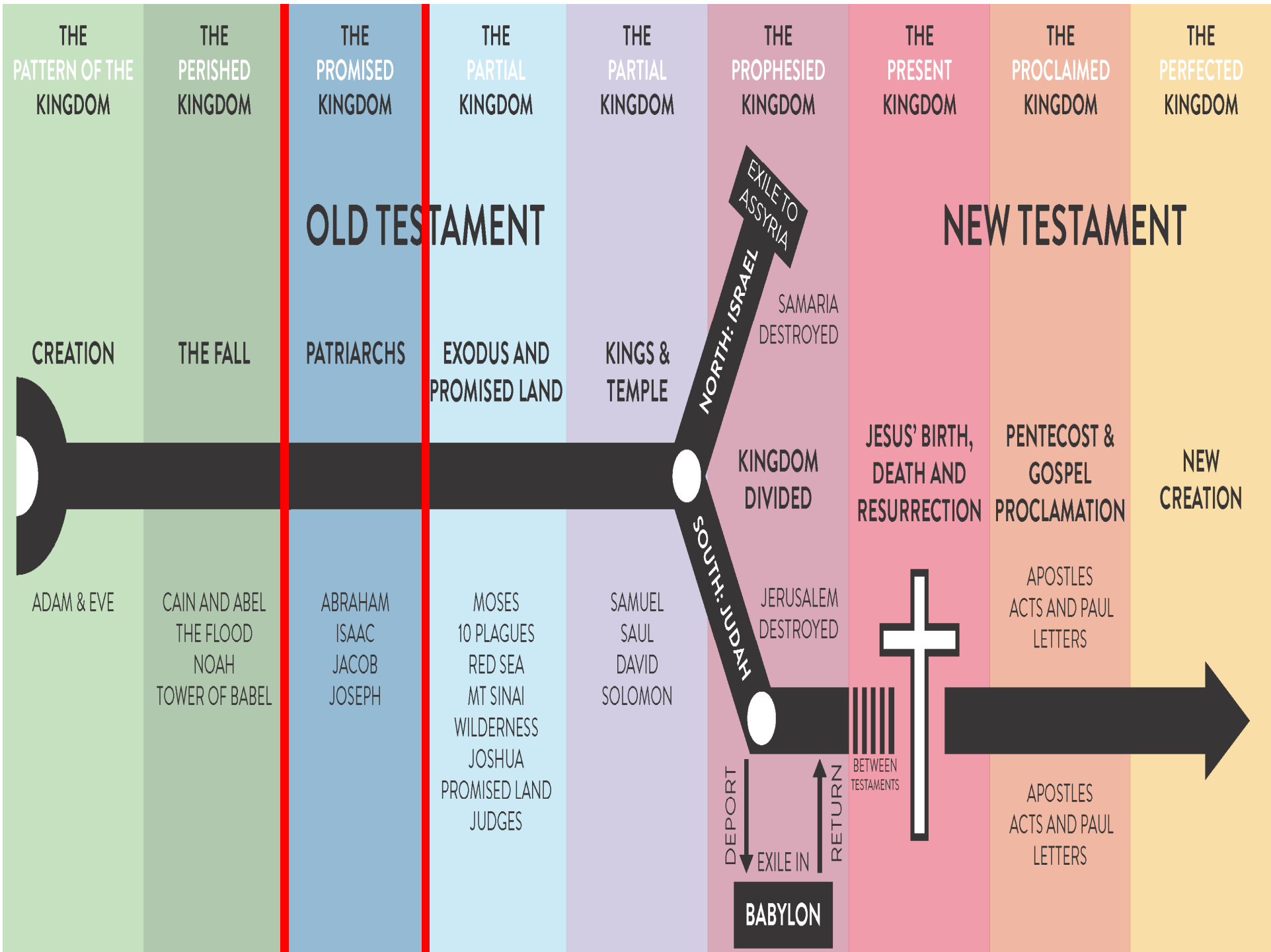
