








# Genesis 4:3-5 King James Version

<sup>4</sup> And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the LORD had respect unto Abel and to his offering:


<sup>5</sup> But unto Cain and to his offering he had no respect...

### Luke 12:16-21 King James Version


16 The ground of a certain rich man brought forth plentifully:

goods.


19 And I will say to my soul, Soul, thou hast much goods laid up for many years; take thine ease, eat, drink, and be merry.
