





THE GREATEST GIFT




“...proclaimed a holiday in the provinces and gave **gifts** according to the generosity of a king.”

—*Esther 2:18*




“Every **good thing given** and every **perfect gift** is from above, coming down from the Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shifting shadow.” —*James 1:17*




“If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven **give good things to those who ask Him.**” —*Matt. 7:11*

WHAT ARE THE GOOD THINGS?

“But the **free gift** is not like the transgression. For if by the transgression of the one the many died, much more did the grace of God and the **gift by the grace** of the one Man, Jesus Christ, abound to the many. The **gift** is not like that which came through the one who sinned; for on the one hand the judgment arose from one transgression resulting in condemnation, but on the other hand the **free gift arose** from many transgressions resulting in justification. For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the **abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness** will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ. So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men.” —*Rom. 5:15-18*
