# How We Are Saved

- 1Corinthians 15:1-4 - “Moreover, brethren, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you received and in which you stand, 2 by which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you--unless you believed in vain. 3 For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures, 4 and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures”



# How We Are Saved

- “Moreover, I declare to you the gospel which I preached to you”
  - Gal. 1:11-12 - “But I make known to you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man. 12 For I neither received it from man, nor was I taught it, but it came through the revelation of Jesus Christ.”
  - Rom. 1:14-15 - “I am a debtor both to Greeks and to barbarians, both to wise and to unwise. 15 So, as much as is in me, I am ready to preach the gospel to you who are in Rome also.”

# How We Are Saved

- “Which also you received and in which you stand... unless you believed in vain”
  - 1Thes. 1:5-9 - “For our gospel did not come to you in word only, but also in power, and in the Holy Spirit and in much assurance, as you know what kind of men we were among you for your sake. 6 And you became followers of us and of the Lord, having received the word in much affliction, with joy of the Holy Spirit, 7 so that you became examples to all in Macedonia and Achaia who believe. 8 For from you the word of the Lord has sounded forth, not only in Macedonia and Achaia, but also in every place. Your faith toward God has gone out, so that we do not need to say anything. 9 For they themselves declare concerning us what manner of entry we had to you, and how you turned to God from idols to serve the living and true God”

# How We Are Saved

- Delivered and received
  - 1Thes. 2:13 - “For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe.”



# How We Are Saved

- “By which also you are saved, if you hold fast that word which I preached to you”
  - Eph. 1:13 - “In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise”
  - Heb. 10:38-39 - ““Now the just shall live by faith; But if anyone draws back, My soul has no pleasure in him.’  
39 But we are not of those who draw back to perdition, but of those who believe to the saving of the soul.”

# How We Are Saved

- If you keep in memory: “For I delivered to you first of all that which I also received: that Christ died for our sins... and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day”
  - Acts 26:22-23 - “Therefore, having obtained help from God, to this day I stand, witnessing both to small and great, saying no other things than those which the prophets and Moses said would come-- 23 that the Christ would suffer, that He would be the first to rise from the dead, and would proclaim light to the Jewish people and to the Gentiles.”

# How We Are Saved

- “According to the Scriptures”
  - 1Peter 1:10-12 - “Of this salvation the prophets have inquired and searched carefully, who prophesied of the grace that would come to you, 11 searching what, or what manner of time, the Spirit of Christ who was in them was indicating when He testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ and the glories that would follow. 12 To them it was revealed that, not to themselves, but to us they were ministering the things which now have been reported to you through those who have preached the gospel to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven-- things which angels desire to look into.”

# How Jesus Was Treated

- Betrayed by a friend
  - Psalm 41:9 - “Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me.”
  - Luke 22:48 - “Jesus said to him, Judas, are you betraying the Son of Man with a kiss?”
- Rejected by His own
  - John 1:11 - “He came to His own, and His own did not receive Him.”

# How Jesus Was Treated

- Condemned without mercy
  - Acts 2:22-23 - “Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know-- 23 Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death”

# How Jesus Was Treated

- Hated by those He loved
  - John 15:25 - “But this happened that the word might be fulfilled which is written in their law, ‘They hated Me without a cause’”
- Condemned without cause
  - Matt. 27:22-23 - “Pilate said to them, ‘What then shall I do with Jesus who is called Christ?’ They all said to him, ‘Let Him be crucified!’ 23 Then the governor said, ‘Why, what evil has He done?’ But they cried out all the more, saying, ‘Let Him be crucified!’”

# How Jesus Saved Us In Spite Of That Treatment

- For enemies and our glory
  - Isa. 53:5, 8 - “But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed... 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment, And who will declare His generation? For He was cut off from the land of the living; For the transgressions of My people He was stricken.”

# How Jesus Saved Us In Spite Of That Treatment

- Unselfishly and of necessity
  - Isa. 53:10-11 - “Yet it pleased the LORD to bruise Him; He has put Him to grief. When You make His soul an offering for sin, He shall see His seed, He shall prolong His days, And the pleasure of the LORD shall prosper in His hand. 11 He shall see the labor of His soul, and be satisfied. By His knowledge My righteous Servant shall justify many, For He shall bear their iniquities.”

# How Jesus Saved Us In Spite Of That Treatment

- Trusting in God
  - “Luke 23:46 And when Jesus had cried out with a loud voice, He said, ‘Father, into Your hands I commit My spirit.’ Having said this, He breathed His last.”
- Praying for enemies
  - Luke 23:33-34 - “And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him, and the criminals, one on the right hand and the other on the left. 34 Then Jesus said, ‘Father, forgive them, for they do not know what they do’”

# How Jesus Saved Us In Spite Of That Treatment

- Ready and willing
  - 1Peter 2:23-24 - “Who, when He was reviled, did not revile in return; when He suffered, He did not threaten, but committed Himself to Him who judges righteously; 24 who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness”



# How Jesus Saved Us In Spite Of That Treatment

- Alone in shame, scorned, mocked, humiliated and accursed
  - Matt. 27:39 - “And those who passed by blasphemed Him, wagging their heads 40 and saying, ‘You who destroy the temple and build it in three days, save Yourself! If You are the Son of God, come down from the cross.’ 41 Likewise the chief priests also, mocking with the scribes and elders, said, 42 ‘He saved others; Himself He cannot save. If He is the King of Israel, let Him now come down from the cross, and we will believe Him.’”

# How We Must Respond

- If we keep this in memory, we will not:
- Love this world
  - 1John 2:15 - “Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.”
- Be indifferent
  - Matt. 24:12 - “And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. 13 But he who endures to the end shall be saved.”

# How We Must Respond

- If we keep this in memory, we will not:
- Complain, murmur, find fault, gossip, make slighting remarks
  - Eph. 4:29 - “Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth, but what is good for necessary edification, that it may impart grace to the hearers.”
  - Jude 16-17 - “These are grumblers, complainers, walking according to their own lusts; and they mouth great swelling words, flattering people to gain advantage. 17 But you, beloved, remember the words which were spoken before by the apostles of our Lord Jesus Christ”

# How We Must Respond

- If we keep this in memory, we will:
- Give as we have prospered
  - 2Cor. 9:12 - “For the administration of this service not only supplies the needs of the saints, but also is abounding through many thanksgivings to God”
- Enter into the work
  - Prov. 10:16 - “The labor of the righteous leads to life”
  - Isa. 6:8 - “Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: ‘Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?’ Then I said, ‘Here am I! Send me.’”



# How We Must Respond

- If we keep this in memory, we will:
- Learn of Him and tell others
  - 2Tim. 2:2 - “And the things that you have heard from me among many witnesses, commit these to faithful men who will be able to teach others also.”

# How We Must Respond

- If we keep this in memory, we will:
- Be faithful in service to God and our brethren
  - 1Cor. 15:58 - “Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.”
  - Titus 3:8 - This is a faithful saying, and these things I want you to affirm constantly, that those who have believed in God should be careful to maintain good works. These things are good and profitable to men.”

- 1Tim. 3:16 - “And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifested in the flesh, Justified in the Spirit, Seen by angels, Preached among the Gentiles, Believed on in the world, Received up in glory.”
