GOD REASSURED HIM OF HIS PRESENCE



Courage: "quality of mind or spirit that enables us to meet danger, opposition, or the challenges of life with fearlessness, calmness, and firmness."




GOD PROMISES <u>US</u> CONDITIONAL SUCCESS
