





#### Length Measurements

The ark was 300 cubits long (450 Feet), 50 cubits wide (75 feet) and 30 cubits tall (45 feet) Gen 6:15






- Weighed 14 tons
- Could carry 43,000 tons














- Genesis 7:23 (NLT)


