- 4 therefore, we ourselves speak proudly of you among the churches of God for your perseverance and faith in the midst of all your persecutions and afflictions which you endure.

- Perseverance = hupomeno = to remain under
- Persecution = attacks from without
- Afflictions = pressure, something pressing upon us

A. The Relevance of Suffering (5)

 This is a plain indication of God's righteous judgment so that you will be considered worthy of the kingdom of God, for which indeed you are suffering.

- "Where is God during this persecution & affliction? Is He out of touch? Is He out of control?
- Is this persecution reward I get for growing in faith & love? Going to last forever? How suffering relate to eternal salvation?
- Misinterpret God's postponement of justice as a cancellation of judgment

- Rest = relief, release, not under pressure
