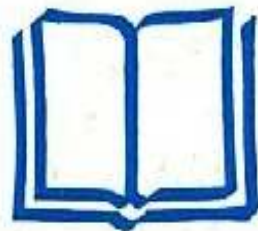

- **Sanctification is made possible today through the word**

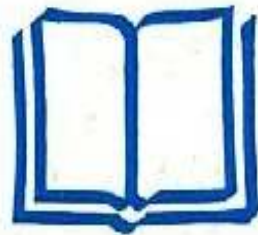
Conclusion:
