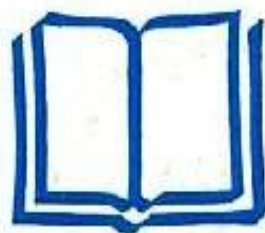

- Miraculous gifts were in effect when the transmission of divine truth was “in part,” but would be done away when the revelation was perfect/complete.

Conclusion:

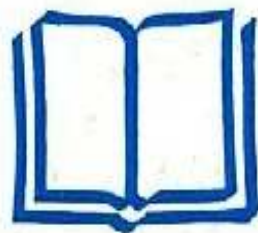
God's word has been revealed and is complete: We need no latter day revelations.
