Philippians 2:9-11

Philippians 2:9-11

- “Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name, 10 that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, 11 and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.”

Jesus Is:

- A - He is the second Adam, Anointed, Apostle, Author, Amen, Alpha, and Ancient of Days.
- B - He is Beginning, Begotten, Beloved, Branch, Bread of Life, Bridegroom, Bright and Morning Star, Bishop of Souls, Brightness of God's glory.
- C - He is Captain, Consolation, Chief Cornerstone, Counselor, Covenant, Chosen of God, and Christ.
- D - He is Deliverer, Dayspring, Daystar, Door, Desire of all nations.
- E - He is Elect, Ensign, and Everlasting Father.
- F - He is Finisher of the Faith, Forerunner, Friend, First Fruits, Faithful Witness, and Fountain of Life.

Jesus Is:

- G - He is God the Son, the Gift of God, Governor, Guide, and Glorious.
- H - He is Help, Hope, Horn of Salvation, Hearer, Healer, Head of the Church, Heir of all things, High Priest, and the Holy One.
- I - He is I AM, Inheritance, Image of God's Person, Immortal, Invisible, and Immanuel.
- J - He is Judah, the Just One, the Judge, and Jesus.
- K - He is King of Israel, King of Kings, King of Glory, and King Everlasting.
- L - He is the Life, the Light, Lily of the Valley, Love, Lion, Lamb, Lawgiver, the Living Stone, and the Lord of Glory.

Jesus Is:

- M - He is Messenger, Messiah, Mediator, Master, Mighty God, and the Mercy of God.
- N - He is the Nazarene.
- O - He is the Offspring of David, Omega, Only Begotten of God, Offering, and Offerant
- P - He is Priest, Passover, Potentate, Prophet, Propitiation, Prince of Life, Prince of Peace, and the Great Physician.
- R - He is Righteous, Rabbi, Ransom, Rest, Root of Jesse, Root of David, Refiner, Refuge, Resurrection, the Rose of Sharon, Ruler, Redeemer, and Rock of Ages.

Jesus Is:

- S - He is the Stone, Shepherd, Son of God, Son of man, Shield, Servant, Seed of woman, Surety, Sufferer, Savior, Sinless Sacrifice, and the Same yesterday, today and forever.
- T - He is Teacher, Truth, Testator, and Treasure.
- W - He is Witness, Word, Way, the Wisdom of God, and the Wonderful.
- Of all the names given to Him, none is as precious, as sweet or as majestic as the name Jesus.

It Is A Special Name

- Originally an old Hebrew name Yeshua (Joshua, Jehoshua, Jeshuah, Hosea) meaning rescuer, deliverer, or savior. A shortened form of JHWH or Jehovah, used in the Exodus to mean “God is salvation.”
- Iesous is the Greek form used in the New Testament, first appearing in the Septuagint version. Later, the Romans adapted it to Iesvs, and was later changed in the English to Jesus.

It Is A Special Name

- It is a name chosen by the Father.
 - Matt. 1:21 - “And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins.”

It Is A Special Name

- It is a name that points back to the Father. The name Jesus means “God is salvation.”
 - 1John 4:8, 16 - “He who does not love does not know God, for God is love... 16 And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him.”

It Is A Special Name

- It is a name that points back to the Father. The name Jesus means “God is salvation.”
 - John 14:9 - “Jesus said to him, Have I been with you so long, and yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'?”
 - John 3:16 - “For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”

It Is A Special Name

- It is a name that portrays the Father.
 - Luke 19:10 - “For the Son of Man has come to seek and to save that which was lost.”
 - 2Peter 3:9 - “The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance.”

It Is A Stainless Name

- In Heaven - There the precious name of Jesus is honored as it can be nowhere else. In Heaven the name of Jesus is a constant source of praise.
 - Rev. 4:8-11, 7:9-12

It Is A Stainless Name

- Rev. 4:8-11 - “The four living creatures, each having six wings, were full of eyes around and within. And they do not rest day or night, saying: ‘Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, Who was and is and is to come!’ 9 Whenever the living creatures give glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever, 10 the twenty-four elders fall down before Him who sits on the throne and worship Him who lives forever and ever, and cast their crowns before the throne, saying: 11 ‘You are worthy, O Lord, To receive glory and honor and power; For You created all things, And by Your will they exist and were created.’”

It Is A Stainless Name

- Rev. 7:9-12 - “After these things I looked, and behold, a great multitude which no one could number, of all nations, tribes, peoples, and tongues, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes, with palm branches in their hands, 10 and crying out with a loud voice, saying, ‘Salvation belongs to our God who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb!’ 11 All the angels stood around the throne and the elders and the four living creatures, and fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, 12 saying: ‘Amen! Blessing and glory and wisdom, Thanksgiving and honor and power and might, Be to our God forever and ever. Amen.’”

It Is A Stainless Name

- In earth
 - Rev. 1:5-8 - “...Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, 6 and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever. Amen. 7 Behold, He is coming with clouds, and every eye will see Him, even they who pierced Him. And all the tribes of the earth will mourn because of Him. Even so, Amen. 8 ‘I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End,’ says the Lord, ‘who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.’”

It Is A Stainless Name

- In Hell -- While Jesus was here on earth, the demons feared Him.
 - Mark 5:2, 6-7 - “And when He had come out of the boat, immediately there met Him out of the tombs a man with an unclean spirit... 6 When he saw Jesus from afar, he ran and worshiped Him. 7 And he cried out with a loud voice and said, What have I to do with You, Jesus, Son of the Most High God? I implore You by God that You do not torment me.”

It Is A Stainless Name

- In Hell -- While Jesus was here on earth, the demons feared Him.
 - Luke 4:41 - “And demons also came out of many, crying out and saying, You are the Christ, the Son of God! And He, rebuking them, did not allow them to speak, for they knew that He was the Christ.”
 - James 2:19 - “You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe--and tremble!”

It Is A Stainless Name

- The day will come when all the demons of Hell and even the Adversary himself will recognize Jesus as Lord.
 - Rev. 20:10 - “The devil, who deceived them, was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone where the beast and the false prophet are. And they will be tormented day and night forever and ever.”
 - Rom. 14:11 - “For it is written: As I live, says the LORD, Every knee shall bow to Me, And every tongue shall confess to God.”

It Is A Stainless Name

- No son of man has ever or will ever be as praised and honored as Jesus.
 - Rev. 5:6-14

Rev. 5:6-14 - "And I looked, and behold, in the midst of the throne and of the four living creatures, and in the midst of the elders, stood a Lamb as though it had been slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth. 7 Then He came and took the scroll out of the right hand of Him who sat on the throne. 8 Now when He had taken the scroll, the four living creatures and the twenty-four elders fell down before the Lamb, each having a harp, and golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints. 9 And they sang a new song, saying: 'You are worthy to take the scroll, And to open its seals; For You were slain, And have redeemed us to God by Your blood Out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation, 10 And have made us kings and priests to our God; And we shall reign on the earth.' 11 Then I looked, and I heard the voice of many angels around the throne, the living creatures, and the elders; and the number of them was ten thousand times ten thousand, and thousands of thousands, 12 saying with a loud voice: 'Worthy is the Lamb who was slain To receive power and riches and wisdom, And strength and honor and glory and blessing!' 13 And every creature which is in heaven and on the earth and under the earth and such as are in the sea, and all that are in them, I heard saying: 'Blessing and honor and glory and power Be to Him who sits on the throne, And to the Lamb, forever and ever!' 14 Then the four living creatures said, 'Amen!' And the twenty-four elders fell down and worshiped Him who lives forever and ever."

It Is A Saving Name

- The meaning of His name -- The name of Jesus speaks about salvation.
 - Acts 4:12 - “Nor is there salvation in any other, for there is no other name under heaven given among men by which we must be saved.”
 - John 3:36 - “He who believes in the Son has everlasting life; and he who does not believe the Son shall not see life, but the wrath of God abides on him.”
 - John 14:6 - “Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.’”

It Is A Saving Name

- 1Cor. 3:11 - “For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.”
- Luke 6:47-49 - “Whoever comes to Me, and hears My sayings and does them, I will show you whom he is like:
48 He is like a man building a house, who dug deep and laid the foundation on the rock. And when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently against that house, and could not shake it, for it was founded on the rock.
49 But he who heard and did nothing is like a man who built a house on the earth without a foundation, against which the stream beat vehemently; and immediately it fell. And the ruin of that house was great.”

It Is A Saving Name

- The ministry of His name.
 - Phil. 2:5-8 - “Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus, 6 who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, 7 but made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant, and coming in the likeness of men. 8 And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.”

It Is A Saving Name

- Thousands died on crosses at the hands of the Romans, and some died for good causes or so that a few others could live. There is nothing special or unique about dying on a cross.
- But only One died on a cross in the service of every human being.

It Is A Saving Name

- The majesty of His name -- He is still alive.
 - Rev. 1:18 - “I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore.”
 - Matt. 28:1-6 - “Now after the Sabbath, as the first day of the week began to dawn, Mary Magdalene and the other Mary came to see the tomb. 2 And behold, there was a great earthquake; for an angel of the Lord descended from heaven, and came and rolled back the stone from the door, and sat on it. 3 His countenance was like lightning, and his clothing as white as snow. 4 And the guards shook for fear of him, and became like dead men. 5 But the angel answered and said to the women, ‘Do not be afraid, for I know that you seek Jesus who was crucified. 6 He is not here; for He is risen, as He said. Come, see the place where the Lord lay.’”

It Is A Saving Name

- And the greatest wonder of all is that He gave us His name.
 - Isa. 62:2 - “The Gentiles shall see your righteousness, And all kings your glory. You shall be called by a new name, Which the mouth of the LORD will name.”
 - Acts 11:26 - “And the disciples were first called Christians in Antioch.”
