

#4: Identifying the Lord's Church for Others


- ◆ If it is a denominational name, it is a denominational church, not the Lord's Church.
- ◆ If it is the Lord's Church, then the name must be an authorized name.
- ◆ There is really no single scriptural name for the Lord's Church in the New Testament.







- Church of God 1Cor. 1:2
- Churches of God 1Thes. 2:14
- Churches of Christ Rom. 16:16
- Body of Christ Eph. 1:22-23
- Kingdom of God Acts 28:31
- Bride of Christ Rev. 21:9
- General assembly and church of the Firstborn - Heb. 12:23

- However, the name alone is not a certain guide.
- ◆ There are over 200 separate denominations that use the name Church of God.

- There many organizations called Churches of Christ that are as denominational as any church of men.
- International Churches of Christ
- United Church of Christ
- Church of Christ (Disciples Movement)
- A number of branches of mainstream denominations have adopted the name Church of Christ in addition to a denominational identity:
 - Missionary and Primitive Baptists
 - Anglican and Episcopal subsets
 - House Church Movement and Community Bible Churches
 - Even some Catholic, Pentecostal, & conservative Presbyterians

Examine The Message Preached

The Importance of the Message

- One is called through the gospel
 - 2Thes. 2:14 "To which He called you by our gospel..."
- When one obeys the gospel, the Lord adds him to His church
 - Acts 2:41, 47 "Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them. 47 And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved."

Examine The Message Preached

- ◆ The Gospel must not be perverted in any way
 - Gal. 1:6-9 "I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, 7 which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ. 8 But even if we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel to you than what we have preached to you, let him be accursed. 9 As we have said before, so now I say again, if anyone preaches any other gospel to you than what you have received, let him be accursed."

Examine The Message Preached

- If the message is different by changing either the *facts or commands* of the gospel, then people are not being saved, and the Lord is not adding them to His church.
- A church with a perverted gospel may have the nicest people, but they are unsaved people.



- The New Testament presents a pattern for the worship, work, and organization of the church, by means of the apostles' doctrine.
 - Heb. 8:5 "...as Moses was divinely instructed when he was about to make the tabernacle. For He said, See that you make all things according to the pattern shown you on the mountain."
 - 2Tim. 1:13 "Hold fast the pattern of sound words which you have heard from me..."
 - Acts 2:42 "And they continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers."

- ◆ Their worship will be described in the New Testament:
 - Singing Col. 3:16; Eph. 5:19
 - Prayer Col. 4:2
 - Preaching Acts 20:7
 - Communion 1Cor. 10:16-17, 11:23-29
 - Offering 1Cor. 16:1-2
 - Their assemblies will be designed to edify and encourage each other to greater love and good works -Heb. 10:23-25

- Their work as a congregation will follow the pattern found in scripture
 - Equipping the saints for ministry (edification) Eph.
 4:11-16
 - Spreading the gospel by supplying and sending out evangelists (evangelism) - Phil. 4:15-16; 3John 5-8
 - Meeting the needs of the saints as problems arise
 (limited benevolence) Rom. 15:25-26; 1Cor. 16:1-4;
 2Cor. 8:1 9:15

- ◆ Their **organization** as a congregation will be that which is found in the New Testament Phil. 1:1
 - With <u>elders</u> qualified to oversee and tend to the local congregation - Acts 14:23, 20:28; 1Tim. 3:1-7; Titus 1:5-9; 1Peter 5:1-4
 - With <u>deacons</u> also qualified to serve as they minister to the local congregation - 1Tim. 3:8-13
 - With <u>saints</u> (members) who live in this world with conduct that gives glory to God - 1Peter 2:9-12

- By carefully studying the pattern of the Lord's church as revealed in the New Testament, we can know when a congregation is faithfully observing the apostles' doctrine as authorized by Jesus Christ.
- John 17:20-23 "Neither pray I for these alone, but for them also which shall believe on me through their word; 21 That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me. 22 And the glory which thou gavest me I have given them; that they may be one, even as we are one: 23 I in them, and thou in me, that they may be made perfect in one; and that the world may know that thou hast sent me, and hast loved them, as thou hast loved me."
