  - A. Do we trust in God, refusing the rewards of men? Matt. 6:2-4

  - A. God promised a Son; given, this fulfilled Micah 5:2
- 11. The promised son Gen. 21:1-3
  - A. A Son given Luke 2:8-11
- 12. Offer thy son Gen. 22:1-2; Heb. 11:17
  - A. Present self as a living sacrifice Rom. 12:1-2; Mark 10:29
