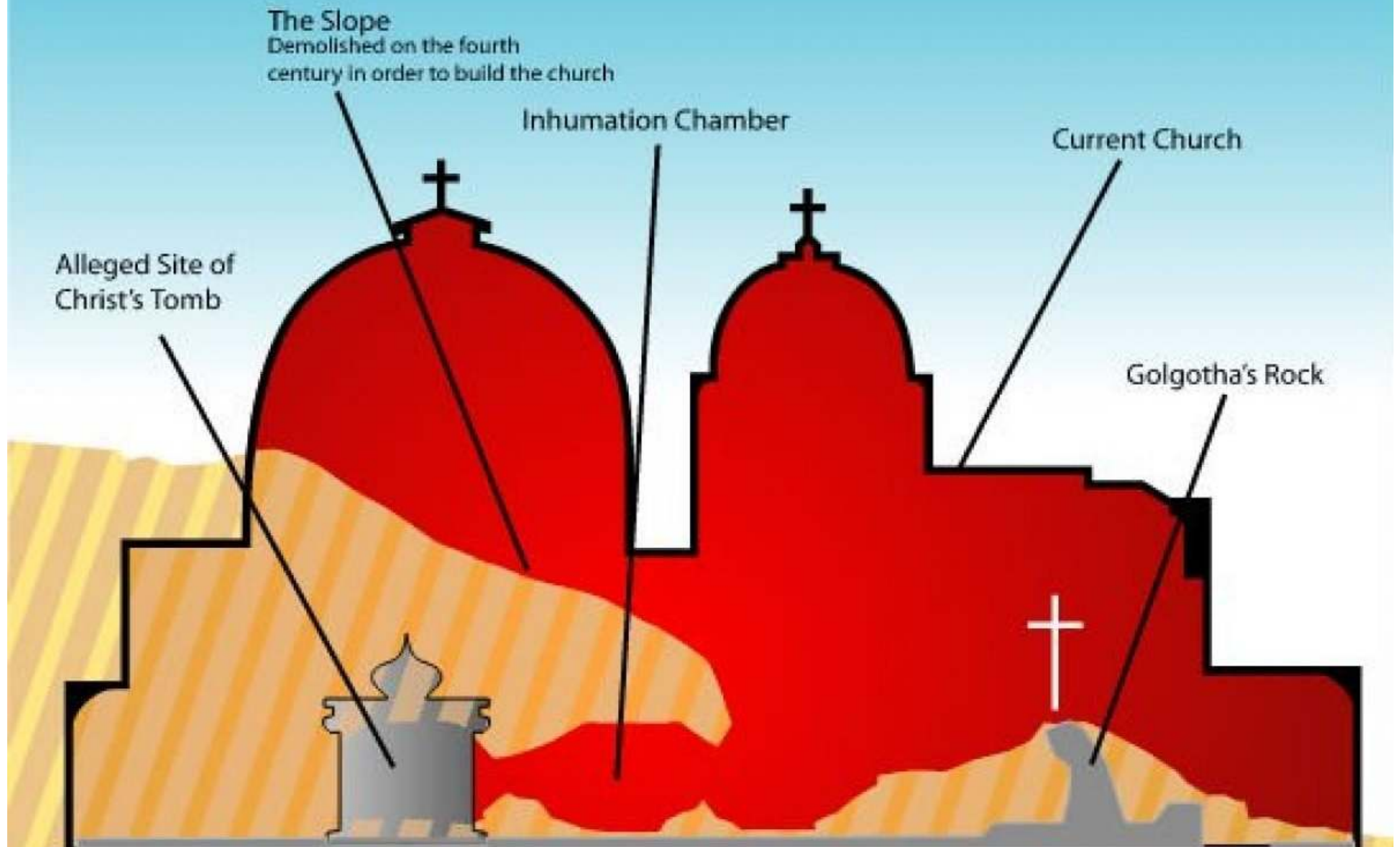




Calvary

⁴ And it came to pass, as they were much perplexed thereabout, behold, two men stood by them in shining garments:


Luke 24:5-8 (KJV)
