Three Members of the Godhead


- All present at creation Genesis 1 and John 1

Three Members of the Godhead

- All present at creation Genesis 1 and John 1
- All present at Jesus' baptism Matthew 3:16-17
- Jesus taught of three members John 14:16-17 and 15:26
- Jesus commanded baptism in the name of the three members – Matthew 28:19
- Paul prays for the blessings of each of the three on the Corinthian brethren – II Corinthians 13:14

The Holy Spirit Possesses the Characteristics of a Personality

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All of these are characteristics of a <u>person</u>, an entity possessing intelligence

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Only a personality can be treated in these ways

The Holy Spirit Possesses <u>Attributes</u> of a <u>Divine</u> Personality

1. His relationship with the Father and the Son

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"Omniscient" - Authority to declare what is true

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- 3. He is Omnipresent

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"Omnipresent" - Real existence in every time and place

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- 4. He is Omnipotent

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"Omnipotent" - Control over all things

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- "All of these activities require unlimited power, which belongs only to <u>Deity</u>"
