Context:

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Who is speaking?

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Matthew 12:31-32:

- Jesus is speaking (v 25)
- Speaking to the Pharisees (v 24)
- Countering "Beelzebul" claim (v 24)

Context:

Mark 3:28-30:

- Jesus is speaking (v 23)
- Speaking to scribes who came from Jerusalem (v 22)
- Countering "Beelzebul" claim (v 22)

Context:

#### Luke 12:10:

- Jesus is speaking (v 1)
- Speaking to His disciples warning them of the Pharisees (v 1)
- Countering the Pharisees' unbelief, including their "Beelzebul" claim (11:15)

#### Background:

Jesus casting out demons by "Beelzebul?"

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  - Inconsistent Their own exorcists (v 27)
- Cast out demons through the Holy Spirit (v 28, also Luke 11:20) – The Holy Spirit is the power by Whom God acts
- In casting out demons, Jesus is binding Satan, "the strong man" (v 29, also Luke 11:21-22)

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- Also Mark 3:30: "because they were saying 'He has an unclean spirit"
- Luke 12:9: "denied before angels"

Luke 12:10: "it shall be forgiven him"

Despite <u>all</u> they were witnessing, these scribes and Pharisees were showing contempt for God and sacred things: Not just a spoken curse, but total rejection of something so evident that the Holy Spirit was performing during that era through Jesus - Too far gone to repent!

Some actions against Holy Spirit in "this age:"

 Lie to/test Holy Spirit – Acts 5:3,9 – Ananias and Sapphira

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- "Sun that melts butter can harden clay"
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- Sacrifice under Old Law has been done away.
   What is left if Christ's sacrifice is rejected?

I John 5:16-17 - "sin leading to death"

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- We can pray for change of a sinner's attitude, but they must take the action for themselves

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
