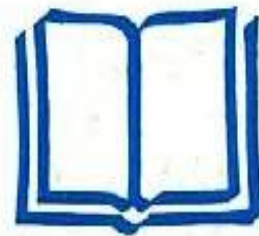

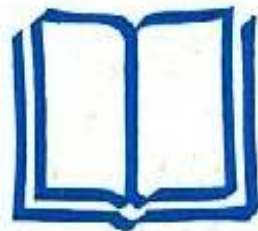
Conclusion:
